At St Paul's Dental Practice we respect your right to privacy and are committed to maintaining your confidence and trust. We understand the importance of protecting the personal information that we obtain from you.

This website uses Google Analytics to help analyse how users use the site. Our web server automatically collects and aggregates information about your visit to www.stpaulsdentalpractice.co.uk, including your IP address, service provider, browser type, domain names of referring websites, operating system, pages accessed on our website, and the date and time of your access.
